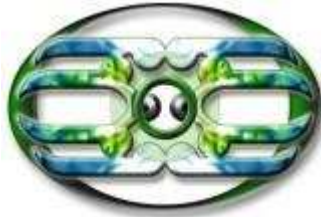


# Te Ngutu Kura for Mac Lion - Installation Instructions

Download Te Ngutu Kura for Macintosh from <http://www.maorispellchecker.net.nz>

There may be a few problems installing Te Ngutu Kura, as you may not be able to find the **Home/Users/'UserName'/Library/Spelling** folder. Lion now hides the User's Library folder.

1. Download the two files **mi\_NZ.aff** and **mi\_NZ.dic** to your **Downloads** folder.
2. Open a new Finder window.
3. Hold down the **Option (⌘)** key and click on the **Go** menu in the menu bar.
4. With the **Option (⌘)** down you'll see the **Library** listed as a folder. [Without the **Option (⌘)** key that folder does not appear in the list.]
5. Select **Library** from the **Go.** menu. The contents of the **Library** folder are listed in the window you opened at Step 2.
6. Open the **Spelling** folder.
7. **Drag** the **mi\_NZ.aff** and **mi\_NZ.dic** files into the **Spelling** folder.

**Note:** you may need to quit and re-open the software you're using so that it recognises the newly added spellchecker.
