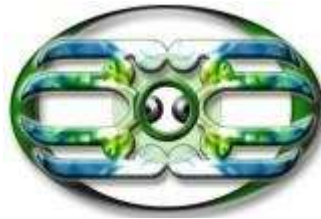

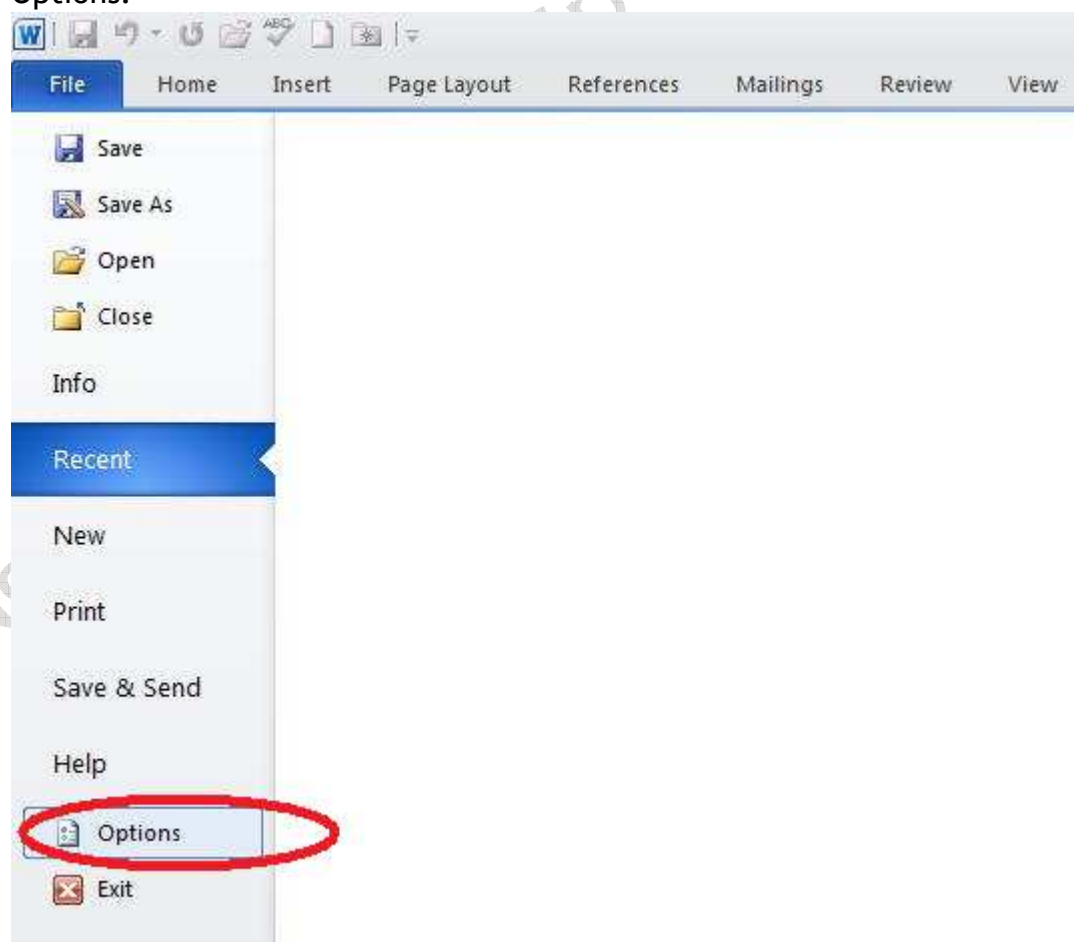

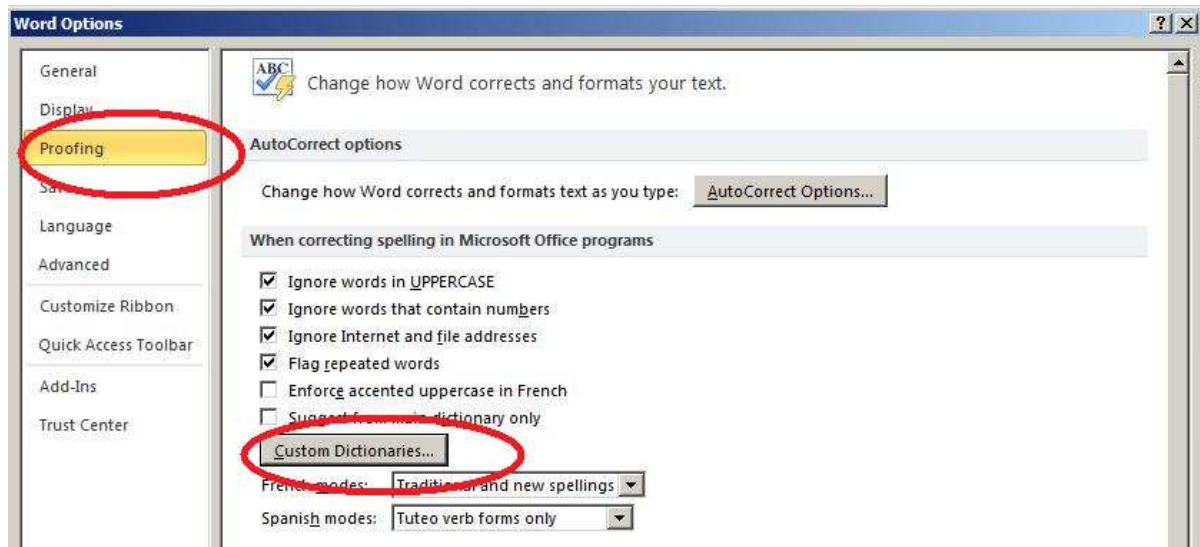
After installing Te Ngutu Kura...

1. Open Microsoft Word 2010
2. Click File
3. Click Options.

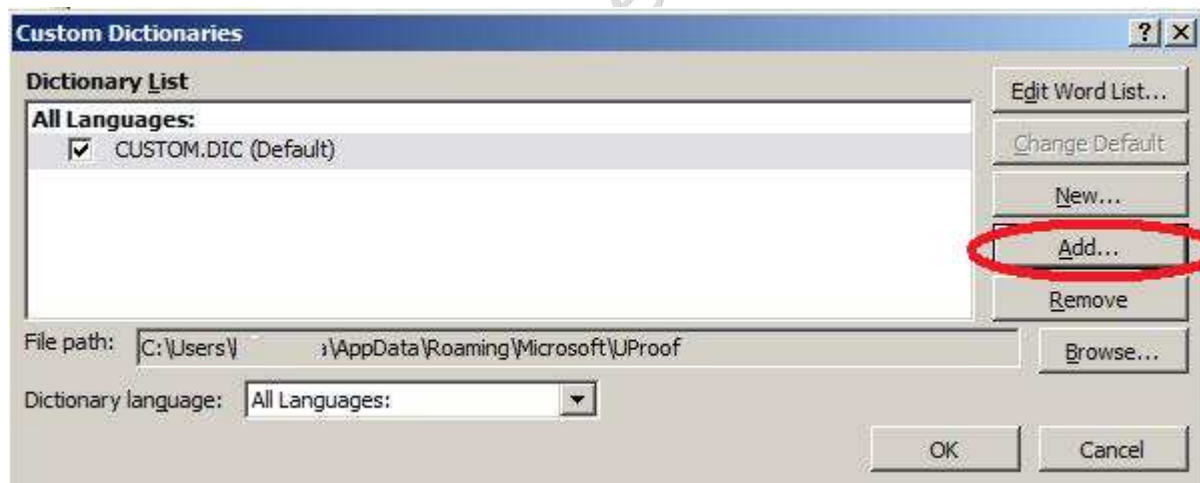


4. Click Proofing

5. Click Custom Dictionaries



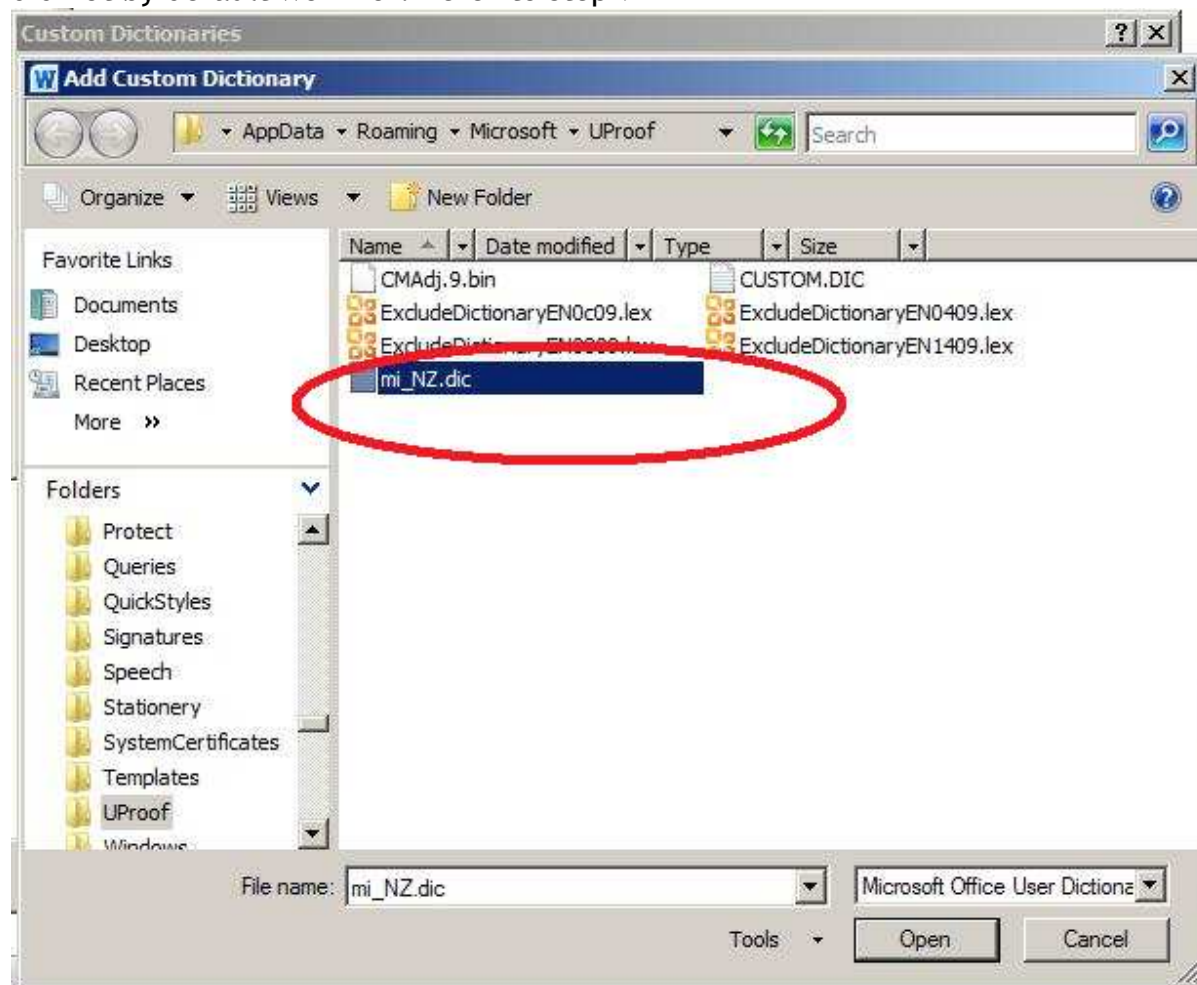
6. Click Add



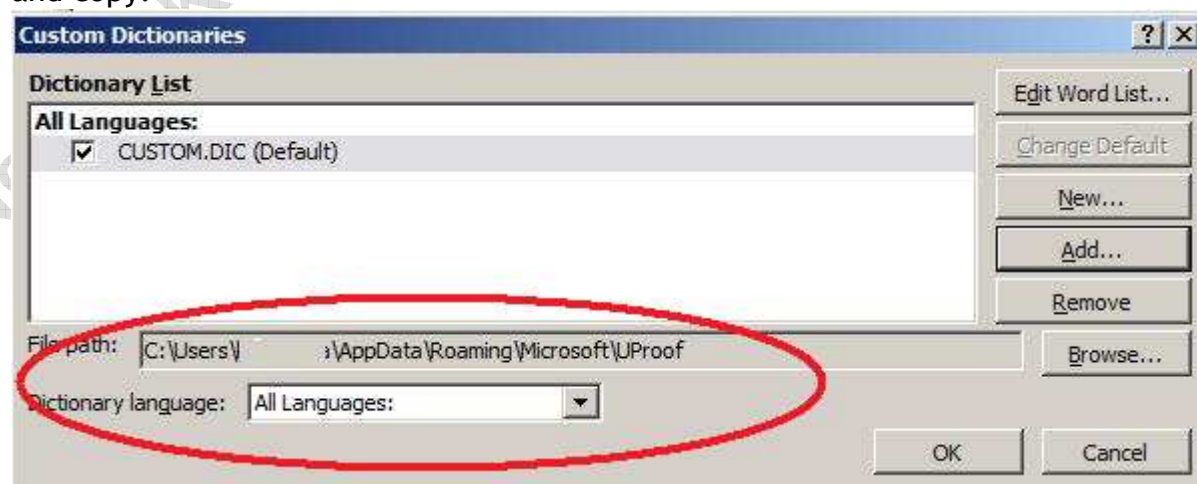
7. Select mi_NZ.dic or for Aotearoa Place Names placenames.dic .

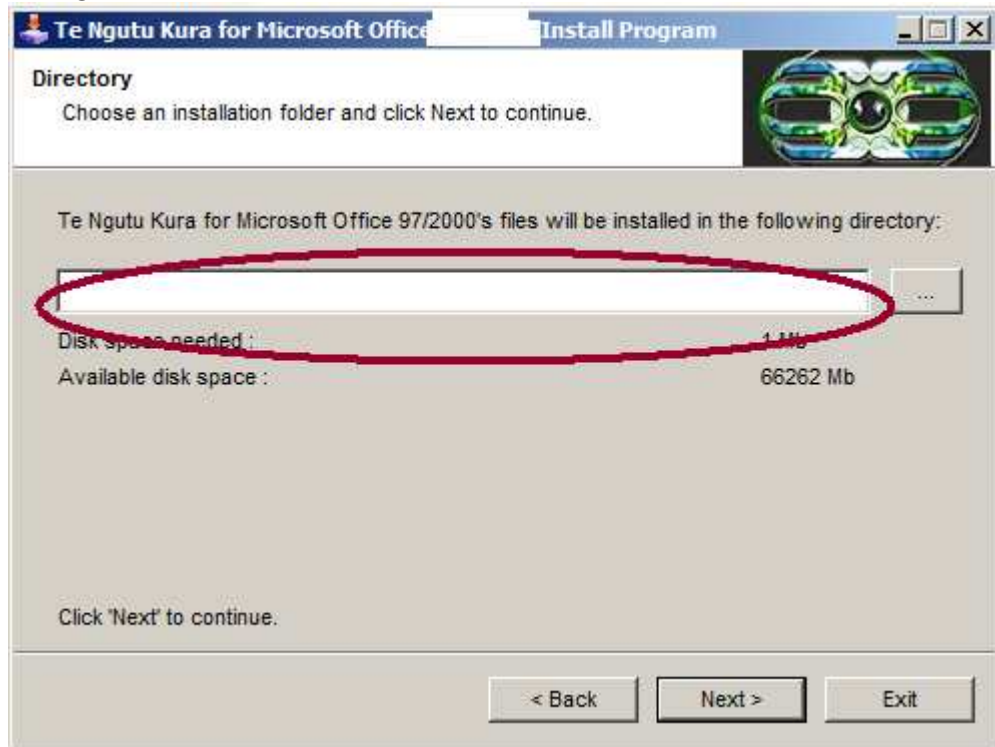

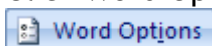

2. Click Word Options.

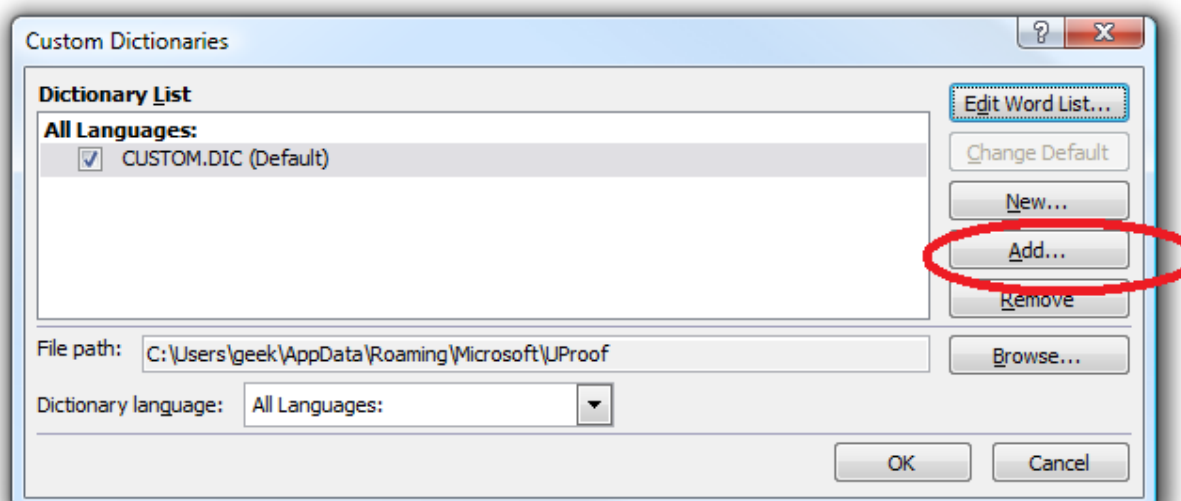

After installing Te Ngutu Kura...

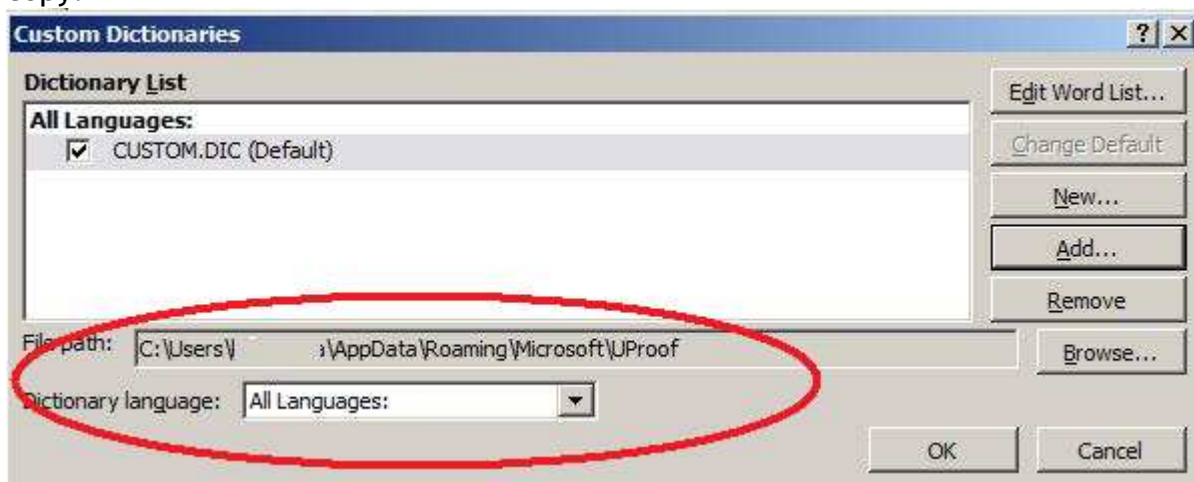
1. Click Options on the Tools menu.

3. Click Custom Dictionaries.



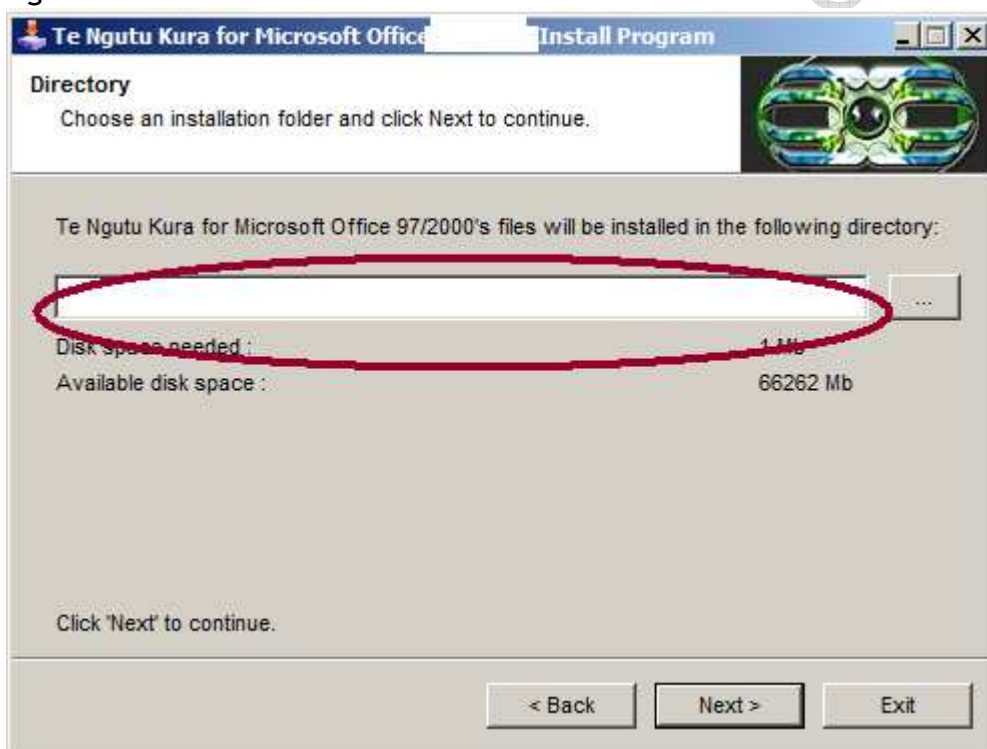
